## Uvodnik

Svrha rada *Testiranje nestabilnosti ekonomskog rasta u tranziciji: Slučaj balkanskih zemalja* je dati pregled najnovije literature o nestabilnosti rasta i empirijski analizirati koncept nestabilnosti rasta u slučaju balkanske grupe zemalja u tranziciji, primenom jednostavne linearne regresione analize na seriji podataka o rastu BDP-a. Zaključci ukazuju na to da je potrebna dublja analiza nestabilnosti rasta u toku tranzicije i novi koncept rasta.

Cilj rada *Nestandardne mere monetarne politike – mehanizam za prevazilaženje problema u sprovođenju neoliberalnog koncepta monetarne politike u uslovima finansijske krize* je da se sagleda uloga nestandardnih mera monetarne politike kao mehanizma za prevazilaženje problema u sprovođenju neoliberalnog koncepta monetarne politike u uslovima finansijske krize, naglašavajući činjenicu da su neoliberalni koncept zagovarale najrazvijenije zemlje.

U radu *Ocenivanje uticaja poreskih oblika na ekonomski rast u SAD* autori istražuju kako porezi utiču na ekonomski rast. Korelaciona matrica reflektuje snažnu i pozitivnu vezu između rasta poreskih prihoda i poreza na dobit kompanija, s jedne strane, i rasta bruto domaćeg proizvoda, s druge strane.

S obzirom na činjenicu da efikasnost posrednika direktno utiče na efikasnost partnera sa kojima su oni povezani, odnosno proizvođača i potrošača, cilj istraživanja prikazanog u radu *Analiza uspešnosti kanala distribucije – maloprodajni lanci u Republici Srbiji* jeste analiza uspešnosti i značaja kanala distribucije, kako sa aspekta partnera unutar kanala, tako i sa makro aspekta, uz poseban osvrt na maloprodavce, kao primarne učesnike kanala distribucije u Republici Srbiji.

Osnovna svrha rada *Ekološka revizija u funkciji unapređenja i zaštite životne sredine* je da objasni načine na koje ekološka revizija doprinosi unapređenju i očuvanju zaštite životne sredine, a praktična primenjivost dobijenih rezultata istraživanja se sastoji u davanju konkretnih predloga za smanjenje zagađivanja i unapređenje zaštite životne sredine.

Autori rada *Uloga elektronskog poslovanja u reinženjeringu i integraciji poslovnih procesa* u elektronskom poslovanju vide inicijatora i uzrok radikalnih promena u poslovnim procesima koje se karakterišu kao reinženjering. Prema autorima, osnov ovih napora je redizajn i promena poslovnih procesa.

## Editorial

The main purpose of the paper *Testing instability in growth patterns in the course of transition: evidence for Balkan countries* is to review the very recent literature on instability in growth and to empirically analyse it in the case of Balkan group of transition economies, performed by use of the simple linear regression analysis on the GDP growth data series. The results suggest that an in-depth study of the instability of growth in the course of transition is needed, as well as a novel growth concept.

The aim of the paper *The non-standard measures of the monetary policy – mechanism for overcoming problems in the implementation of the neoliberal concept of monetary policy during a financial crisis* is to examine the role of non-standard measures of monetary policy as a mechanism for overcoming problems in the implementation of the neoliberal concept of monetary policy in the conditions of the financial crisis, emphasizing the fact that the neoliberal concept was supported by the most developed countries.

In the paper *Estimating the impact of taxes on the economic growth in the United States* the authors explore how taxes affect economic growth. Correlation matrix reflects a strong and positive relationship between tax revenue growth and corporate income tax on the one side and gross domestic product growth, on the another side.

Due to the fact that the efficiency of the intermediaries directly affects the performance of related partners, producers and consumers, the objective of the research presented in the paper *Analysis of distribution channels' successfulness –the case of the retail chains in the Republic of Serbia* is the analysis of the successfulness and importance of distribution channels, from partners' point of view, as well as from macro aspect, with special reference to the retailers, as the primary participants in the distribution channel, in the Republic of Serbia.

The main purpose of the paper *Environmental audit for environmental improvement and protection* is to explain the ways in which environmental audit contributes to improving and preserving environmental protection and practical applicability of research results consists in giving specific proposals to reduce pollution and improve environmental protection.

The authors of the paper *The role of electronic business in the reengineering and integration of business processes* observe the electronic business as an initiator and the cause of radical changes in business processes characterised as reengineering. According to the authors, the basis of these efforts is a redesign and change of business processes.
